## PROTECTIVE ORDER REGARDING FORENSIC INTERVIEW OF MINORS

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Lake County Child Advocacy Center shall make available a copy
of the digitally recorded forensic interview(s) of
on, to (attorneys, GAL and/or retained experts)
subject to the following restrictions:

- 1. The forensic interview link shall not be exhibited, shown, disclosed, disseminated or displayed to any person, or used in any fashion by any party to this action, except in any administrative or judicial proceeding or as may be directly necessary in the preparation of such a proceeding, unless otherwise ordered by the Court.
- 2. A party shall obtain leave of court prior to forwarding or copying the link to the forensic interview. An Acknowledgement of Receipt of Protective Order shall accompany any copy of the link and the party in receipt shall sign said Acknowledgment. At the conclusion of this case, all parties shall account for any such copies or forwarded information.
- 3. The parties may personally review the discovered materials referenced in Paragraph 2 above in the direct presence and under the direct supervision of their counsel, investigator, or expert witness as may be necessary for the purposes of litigation in the above referenced matter. Under no circumstances shall any party be given the link to the interview to retain in their possession. Neither the discovered materials, nor any copy of such materials, shall be taken out of the State of Illinois without the express prior authorization of the court.
- 4. This protective order shall be applicable to the legal guardian, mother, father, minor, and any attorney for the mother, father, or minor, any investigator, expert witness, child's representative, agent or representative of the mother, father or minor or guardian ad litem.
- 5. Any violation of this order may result in sanctions by this court, including contempt, and may be punishable by state of federal law.
- 6. This order shall be continuing in nature and shall apply whether the case is pending before any administrative or judicial body who is set to make a determination regarding the above referenced matter.
